Troubleshoot



Test for sound

Play a TV show or movie and check for sound through the headphones.

✓ Tip: To stop sound from your TV speakers, go to Settings → Audio and select "TV Speakers Off."



Troubleshoot



If there's no sound...

Q Check the cable connections and make sure they are fully plugged in.

Make sure the TV's audio output is set to the correct source (optical, AUX, or RCA).

Try changing the TV's audio format to PCM (for optical connections).

C Restart the TV, transmitter, and

headphones.

Need help



Important notice

- Our Duet headphones connect to the transmitter using 2.4GHz technology, rather than Bluetooth.
- They cannot connect directly to audio source devices via Bluetooth.







Connect via AUX

 Plug one end of the AUX cable into the TV's Plug headphone jack.
 Plug the other end into the transmitter's "AUX" port.

Troubleshoot



Connect via RCA

⚠ Note

- RCA adapter is **NOT** included.
- Use RCA ports labeled "Audio Out."
- Contact us for a free RCA to AUX adapter if needed.

Minimize interference

- Interference may occur due to nearby devices operating on the 2.4GHz frequency, such as Wi-Fi routers, access points, or even a working microwave oven.
- To minimize disruptions, please ensure these devices are positioned as far away as possible from the headphones and transmitter.

Transmitter enter pairing

Hold the OFF/ON/PAIR button in the PAIR position for 3 seconds until the LED flashes (1) (2)

Pair your headphones

Hold the OFF/ON/PAIR button in the PAIR position for 5 seconds until the LED flashes (pairing mode).

Switch audio modes



Balanced Mode – Suitable for most users.

Clear Voice Mode – Designed for users with moderate to severe high-frequency hearing loss. **Mono/Stereo Button** – When set to Mono, both earcups produce the same sound, ideal for individuals with hearing loss in one ear.
