

Initial Setup

Key Functions



- 1 MFB Button
 - Pair: Hold 2s → LED flashes
 - Connected: LED solid
- 2 Volume + & Buttons
 - Reset: Hold both for 6s → LED
 - solid of for 3s

① We suggest setting up **before** your flight to ensure everything works smoothly.






Turn Bluetooth OFF on nearby devices

Your headphones might connect to other devices $\square \square$.

Turn Bluetooth **off** on nearby devices for each use.



Press & hold the MFB for **5** seconds until the LED flashes red & blue .



2. Close the lid and wait for 5-6 seconds.




3. Take the earbuds out again. They will automatically enter pairing mode.

Troubleshoot

Troubleshooting

Press & hold both the - & + buttons for about **7 seconds** or until the LED flashes **pink** . The Relay will then automatically re-enter pairing mode.



Plug the Relay in

Plug into an in-flight entertainment system or any 3.5mm AUX source (adapter may be needed).



Test for sound

Turn your audio source on and check for sound through your headphones.

If there's no sound, try adjusting the volume on either the Relay or the audio source.

Audio lag?

If you notice a lag in sound

For minimal delay, use headphones supporting aptX Adaptive or Low Latency.

Using non-aptX devices like AirPods may result in up to 200ms delay.

Check compatible devices on the aptX product list /

You can connect & simultaneously listen through 2 pairs of headphones if desired.

Put the Relay in pairing mode again

Ensure Headphone 1 is connected (do **NOT** put earbuds back in their case).

Press & hold the MFB for 5 seconds or until the LED starts flashing red & blue .

- 2 Once connected, both of the Relay's LEDs will turn solid blue .



Test for sound

You should be able to hear audio through both pairs of headphones.

If there is **no sound**, turn **off** the Relay and both pairs of headphones, then turn them back on.

Troubleshoot

Troubleshooting

If both pairs are connected but one has no sound, **turn off** the silent pair and turn them **back on**.

For **AirPods**, place the silent pair back in the charging case, wait for 3 seconds, then take them out again.

If the issue persists, turn off the transmitter and both pairs of headphones. Then, turn them back on to re-establish the connection.

Need help

If you notice a lag in sound

It may be because your headphones do NOT support **low-latency** technology.

For the best latency performance, use headphones that support **aptX Adaptive** or **aptX Low Latency**.

If you're using a non-aptX device, such as AirPods, you may experience a slight audio delay.


